
Parent Week At A Glance November 24 - November 30, 2024

Things You Need to Know About the ECSD Annual Survey

1. WHAT IS THE ECSD ANNUAL SURVEY?

The ECSD Annual Survey is held every year, giving you the opportunity to share feedback on how schools and the Division are performing. Paper surveys are distributed through schools or mailed directly to homes and can be easily returned using the provided envelope. This annual process helps Edmonton Catholic Schools improve and grow with your valuable input.

2. WE NEED YOU TO TELL US HOW WE ARE DOING

Edmonton Catholic Schools believes it is important to hear your thoughts on the overall performance of your child's school and the Division so that we can see what's working and what needs to be improved. The results of the ECSD Annual Survey will help inform our schools, sites, and departments and will be publicly shared with our Board of Trustees to support their decision-making.

At the Division level, we use the information from this survey to determine if there are areas that we need to spend more time and resources to provide the best possible experience for our students, families, and staff. Schools, in particular, look at their specific site-based information and build their growth plans to improve the experiences for their students, families, and staff.

When being dropped off at school, please know that there is **no supervision at the park** in the morning. Students are to go directly to the back where there is supervision.



Students are expected to dress appropriately for the weather. Students D0 N0T go outside if the temperature and windchill is **-20 degrees** or colder. If temperatures are above -20C, students will be going outside, so dressing warmly is important!

Volunteers at St. Charles-

All people wishing to volunteer with us will need to complete a **volunteer form** for the year. Some parents will require a police record check (PIC) and child welfare check (IRC) if they are going on field trips or working with students. Please provide your child's teacher with your email address and interest in volunteering.

Police Information checks for volunteers, ages 18 and above, can be obtained free of charge directly from Edmonton Police Services, with a voucher which is provided by our Division.

The voucher must be **used within 1 week of obtaining** it. Please check your junk mail if you haven't received it.

Some field trip volunteers may also require an IRC to be completed, which is free.

Please note that the clearance is valid for one year from the date it was issued.


