Charles founded schools for the poor, seminaries for clerics, and through his community of Oblates, trained priests for holiness of life. Charles founded hospitals where he himself served the sick. He gave away all his possessions and wore an old, patched cloak. During the great plague, he personally brought aid to the sick and dying. He died in 1583 and was canonized. He was one of the towering figures of the Catholic Reformation, a patron of learning and the arts, and though he achieved a position of great power, he used his authority with humility, personal sanctity, and unselfishness in bringing about reform within the Church.

A Day in Kindergarten

The daily schedule happens in a sequence that occurs the same way every day with clear, established expectations for arrival, transitions and dismissal

- Play-based opportunities are woven through the Kindergarten Program to support the child's natural curiosity as they begin to conceptualize the curriculum outcomes being taught.
- In this exciting new community, children's natural curiosity and eagerness to learn are structured through organized activities
 and purposeful play. Your child will interact, imagine, experiment, and explore to add to their knowledge, learn new skills, and
 practice what they've learned.
- The Catholic faith is permeated throughout our Kindergarten programs. Song, prayer, stories, and symbols are just a few
 examples of how Christ's teachings may be integrated into your child's daily routine.

Staggered Entry

Each child will attend one staggered entry time slot. Then, all kindergarten students will start school on Monday, September 8. You will receive a phone call from the teacher by August 29th to let you know what day and time your child will attend staggered entry.

Early Literacy in Kindergarten

Early literacy in kindergarten focuses on children being actively engaged in acquiring language and constructing their own understandings of how language works.

Children become confident language users through many opportunities to listen and speak, read and write, and view and represent. Students will:

- Explores listening and speaking skills
- Focuses on developing new vocabulary through stories, poems, rhymes, illustrations and games.
- Learn about various story elements such as character, setting, problem, and resolution.
- Engage in daily explicit and systematic phonological and phonemic awareness lessons
- Learn letter names, sounds and proper formation.
- Engage in phonics lessons that focus on making words through sounds.

Early Numeracy in Kindergarten

In Kindergarten students will develop number sense by comparing, representing and recognizing quantities of numbers 1 through 10. Students will demonstrate an understanding of repeating patterns and how to use direct and indirect measurement to compare objects Lastly, children will also learn to describe the characteristics of 3D objects and 2D shapes, while analyzing the relationships among them.


Physical Skills and Well Being

A healthy body is part of a healthy life. Your child will begin to develop a love for physical activity through movement, games, and activities, while developing both fine motor and gross motor skills. They will use a variety of equipment, learn basic locomotor and non-locomotor skills and learn about what it means to be healthy.

Assessment

Your child's understanding of the learning outcomes is reported to parents through student portfolios (digital – Spaces Edu) and a June report card on PowerSchool completed by the classroom teacher.
