I look forward to sharing and exploring these ideas with our staff during our upcoming Professional Development Day on Thursday, January 29.

One learning condition of critical importance is student mental health. I am proud of the work we have begun at our school through our Student Wellness Team, as well as the support provided to students by our Emotional Behaviour Specialist and Family School Liaison Worker. Together with our parents, our school team truly represents the “village” that supports our children as they grow, learn, and thrive.

This week we celebrate our new Archbishop-designate Stephan Hero. Born and raised in Edmonton, he was ordained for the Archdiocese of Edmonton, taught at Newman Theological College, and served as rector of St. Joseph Seminary. In 2021, he was appointed Bishop of Prince Albert. He now returns home and will be installed as Archbishop of Edmonton on Friday, January 23, 2026 at St. Joseph's Basilica. Important Reminders

Drop Off Zones/Designated Handicapped Parking

We continue to have issues with our drop off and pick up of students. To ensure safety and speedy drop off and pick up we ask parents to please be mindful of the wait times in these zones as traffic becomes backed up very quickly.

One solution is to turn right after you have dropped off your child. Trying to turn left past the drop off is slowing everyone down and creates a backlog of vehicles especially during peak times.


Snow Clearing



When Is a Child Ready to Celebrate These Sacraments?

Children must be a minimum age of 7 years and in Grade 2 or higher.

What Do I Need in Order to Register?

1. A copy of your child's Baptism certificate (unless your child was baptized at St. Charles).
2. A registration fee of \$50 for materials is requested (cheque, cash, or e-transfer to office@saint-charles.com).

Parental Involvement:

It is mandatory for all children to be present at each class along with a parent (or another adult). Children will have homework each week to be completed with the help of a parent or another adult.

2. Tues. Jan. 27 – 2nd class for 1st Reconciliation

4. **Wed. Feb. 4 – Celebration of First Reconciliation**
5. Tues. Feb. 17 – 1st class for 1st Communion
(Tues. Feb. 24 – NO CLASS – Spring Break)
6. Tues. Mar. 3 – 2nd class for 1st Communion
7. Tues. Mar. 10 – 3rd class for 1st Communion
(Tues. Mar. 17th – NO CLASS – Parish Mission)
8. Tues. Mar. 24 – 4th class for 1st Communion

First Communion will be celebrated at the Saturday evening & Sunday masses during the Easter Season. Parents will be able to sign up for the date they wish.

The first three classes will prepare the children for the celebration of First Reconciliation; the remaining four classes will prepare the children for First Communion.

Because there are so few classes for each sacrament, it is necessary that your child attend ALL the classes.

It is mandatory that the children attend Saturday evening or Sunday mass.

Classes for these sacraments will be offered again in the Fall of 2026.
