Parking Lot/Drop Off & Pick Up-High Importance



Please refrain from driving in and out of the parking lot to drop off or pick up your child at the back entrances. In some instances we see parents and students sitting in idling vehicles until the bell rings in the morning or after school. This becomes a dual problem for us in that there is a reduced number of parking spots for staff, and a safety concern for people or children walking through the lot. Please use the drop and go areas and limit the time in these spots so that traffic is not backing up.

We understand that some families have little ones in the car and others may need extra time for drop off, so we ask parents to just wait a bit as the drop off areas clear by circling around or waiting for the buses to leave.

We will not mark students late until after announcements. With the snow and colder temperatures, we understand you may not want your child outside, however please trust that we will let students in if the temperature is below-20 with wind. Supervision is in the back and front starting at 7:45am. Please do not drop off earlier than our supervision time. Our priority is always student safety but we need everyone's cooperation.



Parent & Student ECSD Surveys-Due January 10, 2025

Edmonton Catholic Schools is committed to providing an excellent Catholic education to the more than 50,000 students we serve. We believe it is important to hear your thoughts on the overall performance of your child's school and the Division so that we can see what's working and what needs to be

improved. One of the ways we gather your feedback is through the ECSD Annual Survey. This year, paper surveys are back and will be distributed either through your child's school or sent directly to your home.

How to Participate?

- Fill out a Survey Take a few moments to complete the survey—it's a small step that makes a big difference for our Division.
- One Survey per Child If you have more than one child in ECSD, please complete a survey for each student, focusing on their individual educational experiences.

 Return by January 10, 2025 - Return the survey using the provided business reply envelope. You can send it back through your child's school or drop it in any Canada Post mailbox. Due to the Canada Post strike, you are encouraged to return the survey directly to your child's school.

Inclement Weather



The health and safety of students is a paramount consideration in the organization of outdoor activities and recess. Decisions regarding outdoor activities are to take into consideration inclement weather that may result from the following conditions or combination of conditions:

Continuous rain, Extreme wind, Extreme cold and/or Air Quality.

Environment Canada's weather for Edmonton is the site that is consulted at https://weather.gc.ca/city/pages/ab-50 metric e.html.

The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder.

- During inclement weather (e.g. temperatures below -20° C with windchill) students will be permitted in the school at 7:45 am. Indoor supervisors will be assigned to supervise areas inside the school. Outside bus supervision will still occur from 7:45 am to 8:00 am.
- Recess will occur indoors during inclement weather. Students will remain in their homeroom classes and schedules may be prepared for classes to access the gym during indoor recess breaks.
- Late arrivals of all students after 8:00 am, are, at all times, asked to enter the main doors.
- Students are to re-enter the school at the end of the day if they miss their bus, the bus is delayed, a sibling forgets to meet the student, etc.

Bus Transportation



REMINDERS FROM EDMONTON CATHOLIC SCHOOLS TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

Information regarding pick up and drop off times for your child are found on PowerSchool.

Parents of kindergarten and grade one students are reminded that there must be an ADULT (not an older sibling) at the stop to receive the student. If there is no adult at the stop, the student will remain on the bus and will be returned to school to await pick up.

All transportation enquiries/concerns are to be addressed to the Edmonton Catholic Schools Transportation department at 780-441-6078, NOT the school, bus driver or bus carrier.

Volunteers at St. Charles-

All people wishing to volunteer with us will need to complete a volunteer form for the year. Some parents will require a police record check (PIC) and child welfare check (IRC) if they are going on field trips or working with students. Please provide your child's teacher with your email address and interest in volunteering.

Police Information checks for volunteers, ages 18 and above, can be obtained free of charge directly from Edmonton Police Services, with a voucher which is provided by our Division. The voucher must be **used within 1 week of obtaining** it. Please check your junk mail if you haven't received it.

Some field trip volunteers may also require an IRC to be completed, which is free. Please contact your local Children's Services office or email <u>CS-IRCrequest@gov.ab.ca</u> for a blank form.

Please note that the clearance is valid for one year from the date it was issued. Once you have received your documents, please send them to the office.
