
Parent Week At A Glance March 23- April 5, 2025



St. Charles Catholic School Share Lent Project 2025 Turn Debt into Hope

In this Jubilee year, Pope Francis called on the world to "forgive the debts of countries that will never be able to repay them." Earlier this year, he said, "This is an appeal for solidarity, but above all for justice."

Knowing that 3.3 billion people live in countries that spend more on foreign debt repayment than on health or education, is why the *Social Justice Student Leadership Team* is asking for your support in our fundraising efforts for Development and Peace — Caritas Canada.

Help us understand that we have the power and the duty to act against the injustices that bind people in poverty and debt.


Grant us the courage to challenge the structures that perpetuate these conditions, and the strength to work tirelessly for a world where every person can achieve their full potential.
