

Together, we continue to grow as a community grounded in faith, hope, and service to others.



HEALTHY HUNGER - December 5-IHop

1. All orders MUST be placed 5 days prior to the lunch

date. In most cases, this will be a Sunday.

- 2. If for some reason you placed an order and your child will not be attending school that day, changes can be made up until the 5 day mark. After that day, NO CHANGES may be made. There are 3 options that can be done in the instance that your child is unable to attend that day.....
 - a. You may come and pick up your child's lunch after 12 noon
 - b. You may donate it to another child of your choice
 - c. You may allow the office to donate it to a child in need of a lunch
