
# Parent Week At A Glance February 24 - March 1, 2025

## Pre-Enrollment Period Closes March 14!

Families have until March 14, 2025, to inform schools of their registration plans for



September. It is essential that transition forms are completed for any students transferring to another school before their student files are sent to the receiving school.

To provide clarity:

- By **April 14, 2025**, all existing ECSD students will receive confirmation of their registration requests.
- This confirmation will indicate that the student has been accepted and is officially assigned to their new school for September.

#### To complete your pre enrollment:

- 1. Sign into your PowerSchool account
- 2. click on "Pre-Enrolment for Next Year" to let us know if you will be returning to our school or where you will be attending as you move into Kindergarten or Junior High.
- 3. The pre-enrolment process lets us know how many students to expect in September 2025 and helps us plan for staffing, class sizes, and programming.

### Inclement Weather and Bus Delays



The **suggested guideline** is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder.


