


Important Reminder- Schedule Change for December 19 & 20

Inclement Weather



The health and safety of students is a paramount consideration in the organization of outdoor activities and recess. Decisions regarding outdoor activities are to take into consideration inclement weather that may result from the following conditions or combination of conditions:

Continuous rain, Extreme wind, Extreme cold and/or Air Quality.

Environment Canada's weather for Edmonton is the site that is consulted at https://weather.gc.ca/city/pages/ab-50 metric e.html.

The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder.

• During inclement weather (e.g. temperatures below -20° C with windchill) students will be permitted in the school at 7:45 am. Indoor supervisors will be assigned to

supervise areas inside the school. Outside bus supervision will still occur from 7:45 am to 8:00 am.

- Recess will occur indoors during inclement weather. Students will remain in their homeroom classes and schedules may be prepared for classes to access the gym during indoor recess breaks.
- Late arrivals of all students after 8:00 am, are, at all times, asked to enter the main doors.
- Students are to re-enter the school at the end of the day if they miss their bus, the bus is delayed, a sibling forgets to meet the student, etc.








U of A Nutrition Students at St. Charles

Hello Parents & Guardians!

We are Cindy, Lesley, and Sophie, Nutrition students from the University of Alberta. Over the past few weeks, we've had the opportunity to lead interactive workshops with Grades 4-6 students, focusing on healthy eating. These sessions aimed to enhance food literacy, promote balanced eating, and build an understanding of how food supports overall well-being. Here's a summary of

the topics we've covered:



Hello Parents & Guardians! We are Cindy, Lesley, and Sophie, Nutrition students from the University of Alberta. Over the past few weeks, we've had the opportunity to lead interactive workshops with Grades 4-6 students, focusing on healthy eating. These sessions aimed to enhance food literacy, promote balanced eating, and build an understanding of how food supports overall well-being. Here's a summary of the topics we've covered:

Food Groups

Students were introduced to Canada's Food Guide and its three food groups: whole grains, protein foods, and fruits & vegetables. Through interactive activities, they identified examples of each group while learning the unique roles: grains for energy, proteins for muscle health, and fruits and vegetables for essential nutrients. They practiced categorizing foods into these groups.

Balanced Meals

Students learned about balanced meals and the various ways they can look. They learned that a well-balanced meal contains a variety of food groups, welcomes cultural and traditional foods, and provides a mix of nutrients essential for growth and health. Students had an opportunity to build their own balanced meals.

Describing Food

We explored how the senses of taste, smell, touch, and sight can be used to evaluate and describe food characteristics. For instance, they practiced describing the sweetness of a ripe mango, the crunchiness of celery, the smooth texture of yogurt, or the vibrant colors of a salad. These activities aimed to enhance their descriptive skills and appreciation of the sensory qualities of foods.

Recipe to Try: Veggie and Cheese roll-ups

Ingredients:

- 1 large whole-grain tortilla (or any tortilla of your choice)
- 2 tbsp cream cheese or hummus (for spreading)
- 1/4 cup shredded carrots
- 1/4 cup baby spinach leaves (washed and dried)
- 2 slices of cheese (cheddar, mozzarella, or your favorite type)
- Optional: sliced bell peppers, cucumbers, or avocado

Instructions:

- 1. Prepare the tortilla: Lay the tortilla flat on a clean surface or cutting board.
- 2. Spread the base: Evenly spread cream cheese or hummus across the entire tortilla.
- 3. Layer the veggies and cheese
- 4. Roll it up: Starting at one edge, tightly roll the tortilla into a log shape.
- 5. Slice into pinwheels: Cut the roll-up into 1-inch thick slices.
- 6. Serve and enjoy!

Next Steps for Healthy Eating

- Meal planning Practice planning meals that include a variety of food groups. Provide your child with opportunities for involvement in planning, preparing, or packing meals.
- Food literacy Encourage your child to try new foods and practice describing the taste, texture, smell, and appearance.
- Food preparation skills Include your child when preparing meals to provide hands-on experience in the kitchen!
