

Inclement Weather

Environment Canada's weather for Edmonton is the site that is consulted at https://weather.gc.ca/city/pages/ab-50_metric_e.html.

The suggested guideline is that students do not go outside if the temperature is -20° C or colder, or if the temperature and wind chill factor are -20° C or colder.



What to do when your yellow school bus is running late?

One of the most common questions from families is "What do I do when my yellow school bus is running late?". The website ecsd.net/busdelays has recently been updated to clarify our recommendations for families in the event of bus delays.

We want all families prepared in the event of bus delays. While bus drivers will complete their route, no matter how late they may be running, we recommend that families make alternate arrangements if a bus does not arrive within 20 minutes of its scheduled time.

To help prepare for a delayed bus, families are reminded to:

- Check for delays before you head out the door via the BusPlanner Delays App or the <u>ECSD bus delays website</u>.
- We recommend children wait with a friend or trusted adult at the bus stop.
- Have a plan in case the bus does not arrive. For example, return home or go to a neighbour's house.
- Make alternate arrangements for getting their child to school if needed.
- Dress children appropriately for the weather to withstand any delays or wait times.

Stay Notified

Our Transportation Services team uses several methods to keep families informed about bus delays:

- BusPlanner Delays App: Download the free app on Android or iPhone to receive notifications
- Division Website: Delayed routes are posted at https://ecsd.mybusplanner.ca/Alerts.
- Call Transportation Services at 780-441-6078.

Bus delays can happen, but being ready can make all the difference.
