
Parent Week At A Glance May 4-9, 2025


Upcoming Hot Lunch Dates: Orders for Hot Lunch are due the Sunday prior, before midnight!- June 6- Boston Pizza

SUPERVISION REMINDERS/ Morning Drop off/ Afterschool Playground

Just a reminder that there are no teacher supervisors on the playground before or afterschool. If you are dropping off your child and will not be supervising them, we ask that you send them to the back of the school where the supervisors are located.

In addition, Baturyn School's lunch recess overlaps with our early dismissal on Thursdays. This has caused some issues at the park.
