HEALTHY HUNGER

Our Healthy Hunger program has started up again this year. If you are new to the program, you can visit www.healthyhunger.ca to sign your child up. Click on

create account and follow the steps. You will be prompted to find your child's school as well as their grade and teacher. If you already have an account, you can log in with your same credentials and it will prompt you to add a student. Once lunches have been added, you will see them listed and you can order accordingly. Please note the following

- 1. All orders MUST be placed 5 days prior to the lunch date. In most cases, this will be a Sunday.
- 2. If for some reason you placed an order and your child will not be attending school that day, changes can be made up until the 5 day mark. After that day, NO CHANGES may be made. There are 3 options that can be done in the instance that your child is unable to attend that day.....
 - a. You may come and pick up your child's lunch after 12 noon
 - b. You may donate it to another child of your choice
 - c. You may allow the office to donate it to a child in need of a lunch

In all instances, please call the office ASAP, to let them know what we should do with your child's lunch. If we have not heard from a parent by 11:00 AM your child's lunch will be donated so it does not go to waste.

3. Please make sure to **double check** on the Healthy Hunger website that you have placed your child's order on the Sunday before. If your child's name is not on the list on hot lunch day, unfortunately there is nothing that we can do at the school as it is all done directly through healthy hunger.

NO Registrations will be accepted when classes are full.

When Is a Child Ready to Celebrate These Sacraments?

Children must be a minimum age of 7 years and in Grade 2 or higher.

What Do I Need in Order to Register?

- A copy of your child's Baptism certificate (unless your child was baptized at St. Charles).
- A registration fee of \$50 for materials is requested (cheque, cash, or e-transfer to office@saint-charles.com).

Parental Involvement:

It is mandatory for all children to be present at each class along with a parent (or another adult). Children will have homework each week to be completed with the help of a parent or another adult.

First Communion will be celebrated at the Saturday evening & Sunday masses during the December 2025. Parents will be able to sign up for the date they want.

The first three classes will prepare the children for the celebration of First Reconciliation; the remaining four classes will prepare the children for First Communion.

Because there are so few classes for each sacrament, it is necessary that your child attend ALL the classes.

It is mandatory that the children attend Saturday evening or Sunday mass.

Classes for these sacraments will be offered again in January 2026.
